

She was born and raised in northern Indiana, now working in the Indianapolis area. Her poetry makes the life of a Hoosier come alive, no doubt a considerable factor for selecting her as the Indiana State Poet Laureate for the Bicentennial Celebration year of Indiana statehood (1816). She addresses emotions, wildlife, outdoors settings, and family in many of her poems. Family friendly
